The city has a thriving healthcare system and is an inviting community with many options for seniors looking for assisted living.




The City, which is continually ranked one of the safest cities in the nation, boasts rolling hillside, valley terrain and picturesque views of mountains, streams, parks and city lights.

Now if you senior has been recently been discharged from an Acute Care Hospital often they will be discharged to a Skilled Nursing Facility (SNF).In California there are over 1200 SNF, skilled nursing care facilities, commonly referred to as nursing homes, are licensed healthcare facilities that are inspected and regulated by the state's Department of Health Services.

They offer long- and short-term care for seniors who suffer from serious or persistent health issues, such as Alzheimer's disease, or who need rehabilitation services that are too complex to be treated at home or at an assisted living facility.



Unlike many cities in California, Aliso Viejo really only has one Skilled Nursing Facility. Technically it is a Continuing Care Retiring Community, boosting an array of services for all phases of the aging process.

The Covington gives you many choices as the premier Continuing Care Retirement Community in South Orange County. They offer active Independent Living that is maintenance-free, Assisted Living accommodations, compassionate Memory Care, Skilled Nursing and rehabilitation services, all on there 12 acre campus.



If for some reason you looking for Skilled Nursing, and the Covington doesn't meet your needs (CCRC usually require a considerable "buy in") and this may not be what your loved one is looking for at this time, not to worry there are many other options nearby.

Often after a stay at a Skilled Nursing Facility or Acute Care stay a senior may need to continue the rehabilitation process, but is be well enough to continue the skilled nursing care at home.

"Home health care is a wide range of health care services that can be given in your home for an illness or injury. Home health care is usually less expensive, more convenient, and just as effective as care you get in a hospital or skilled nursing facility (SNF)." As stated on www.Medicare.gov There are currently 80 home health agencies (HHA) that service Aliso Viejo, but physically there is only one HHA located in the city. That being Building Blocks Pediatric Hhs which specializes in treating ill children. That being said with 80 home health agencies that provide care in Aliso Viejo - deciding on what home health care agency to use might seem intimidating. The Internet has numerous (often misleading and overwhelming) sources of information. One very useful tool is on the government website Medicare.gov where you can compare agencies in a geographic area, compare there rankings among other health care agencies and see how they compare to both the state and national care.



Often confusing to many seniors is the difference in the term "Home Health" and "In Home Care" the later meaning assistance with the non medically skilled services such as the normal activities of daily living (ADL's). This type of assistance for the elderly usually includes bathing, grooming, toileting and help dressing. It is reasonable for a caregiver to be expected to do errands, grocery shopping and cooking. In home care unfortunately can be the most expensive type of care usually ranging in price from \$18 - \$22 an hour and is rarely covered by health insurance. Many long-term care insurance plans can pay for it and in certain cases MediCal will allot a nominal amount of funds for In Home Supportive Services (IHSS) and there are certain benefits for Veterans as well.

When you Google "How many home care agencies are in Orange County?" you get about 4,590,000 results in 0.46 seconds. "In home care" is quickly becoming a large industry with over 48 national franchises listed on EntrepreneurMagazine.com There is on one Assisted Living / Residential Care Facilities for the Elderly in Aliso Viejo. This being the Arcadian@Aliso a community capable of providing service to 84 residents. California Community Care Licensing websites reports visiting the facility over 13 times between the years 2012 to 2014, with several A citations (immediate health, safety and personal rights impact) as well as B citations. It's extremely important to note that one or more citations may be under appeal and/or may have been corrected.
